Welcome to Mission!

The following is information you may find useful as a new Family Physician (FP) in Mission. The information in this guide is divided into three sections: **Live, Work, Play.**

A little bit about Mission...

The District of Mission is nestled on a southern coastal mountain slope, overlooking the lush valley of the mighty Fraser River. Founded in 1892, Mission, BC was originally inhabited by the Stó:lō First Nations people, and today this rapidly growing and dynamic centre is home to a population of some 38,000 residents. Ideally situated, Mission is just a 15-minute drive from the US border, and approximately 70 kilometres east of the City of Vancouver. Mission is surrounded by the incredible beauty of mountainous vistas and natural forest settings. Our climate is warm in the summer and mild and wet in the winter. Flowers bloom most of the year, as the area is naturally hospitable to a wide variety of plant life and vegetation. Topographically, Mission enjoys an immense variation of hillsides and gullies which maintain natural neighbourhood enclosures, spectacular views, and a sense of permanence.

Mission has a unique and colourful history. It is the site of Canada's first train robbery, B.C.'s first rail link to the United States, one of the earliest Hydroelectric dams and Fraser River bridges, and is home to the oldest known First Nations' archaeological site in British Columbia.

The municipality has an open and welcoming attitude to its citizens and businesses, new residents, investors and visitors alike. Come and see for yourself why Mission is "the Jewel in the Valley".



Leisure activities around our area are numerous and action-packed. Name any one outdoor activity and Mission can offer it with minimal travel time. Our community is a destination for city dwellers to our west. We enjoy skiing, hiking, boating, shooting, hunting, horse-riding, mountain-biking, swimming, tennis, squash, badminton, kayaking, soccer, airfields, historical sites, cultural activities and great shopping all in or near Mission.

Schooling options are excellent with private and public schooling, including a Francophone school located in town. A Catholic boys' school is based at the beautiful Westminster Abbey, which provides a well known landmark towering over Mission's eastern border.

We have included some local health resource information and community information for your convenience.

About the Mission Division of Family Practice

The Mission Division of Family Practice is a local non-profit society of community-based primary care physicians.

The Division gives local physicians an opportunity to work collaboratively with Doctors of BC, the GPSC, and the Ministry of Health to identify health care needs in the local community and develop solutions to meet those needs.

Together our members work to:

- improve patient access to local primary care
- increase local physicians' influence on health care delivery and policy
- provide professional support for physicians

Benefits of Membership

Attachment Clinic

As part of our A GP for Me strategy, the Attachment Clinic is designed to help patients who do not have a family doctor to find one. We have a full-service clinic which sees a rotation of Mission family physicians who carve out time in their busy schedule to come through and see these patients who are looking for on-going care, with the end goal of getting them meaningfully attached to a family physician.



Mission Out of Hours Service

The Out-of-Hours Service is a developing initiative to increase access to a family physician outside of regular office hours, along with ensuring correct communication with the family physician, and aims to increase use of appropriate services after-hours. Our hotline is staffed by Medical Office Assistants who screen and direct all calls to the physician on-call and advice is provided by telephone, or arrangements are made for assessment in a clinic setting.



MYHouse (Mission Youth House) has partnered with the Mission Division of Family Practice in opening a youth-focused clinic inside the drop-in center. The clinical rooms feature a completely private examination room, along with a nurse-staffed counselling room. We hold drop-in times 2 days per month for the marginalized population who uses MYHouse services to receive medical care from the common cold to mental health.

Mission Friendship Centre

The Friendship Centre, a community centre located in Downtown Mission offers social services, and relevant healing practices for aboriginals and anyone else that requires them. The Mission Division of Family Practice, in partnership, has been able to assist with bringing in a Nurse Practitioner to the Friendship Centre with physician supervision when necessary via telephone.







THINGS TO DO IN MISSION

Hikes and Trails

Stave Dam Forest Interpretive Trail

Self-guided trail that has stops that explain the District of Mission forest management activities in the Mission Municipal Forest. For the best experience, allow for an hour.

Hayward Lake Trails

Pick and choose your route depending on time. Follow the old railway line that wanders along the west side of the lake, taking in the beach and the off-leash dog park. Take the east side which takes you through the forest.

Rolley Lake and Falls Trail

Rolley Lake trail hugs the lake as you enter the forest and then onto a wooden boardwalk that crosses the marsh area. Stop and catch a glimpse of the peaceful lake. Allow for an hour

Fraser River Heritage Park Trails

Self-guided walking tour of Mission's history including the early Oblae mission site and cemetery

Silverdale Wetlands Park Trail

A flat gravel trail with a series of bridges and lookouts over the wetlands habitat

Parks

Fraser River Heritage Park

Offers spectacular views of the Fraser Valley. The park is also home to the historic ruins of St. Mary's Mission and Indian Residential School

Jake Poole Harbourside Park

Take in the views of the mighty Fraser River while enjoying your picnic

Centennial Park

This park offers short trails, a playground, tennis, lacrosse courts and disc golf.

Campus of Care in Mission

The Cedars

Assisted Living for Seniors owned and operated by the Mission Association for Seniors Housing (M.A.S.H).

The Residence in Mission (T.R.I.M.)

Residential care home organized into eight neighbourhoods, each having their own dining and lounge areas and access to a shared country kitchen. There are 25 people in each neighbourhood. Additionally, there are 4 beautifully landscaped courtyards and 6 large balconies for residents to enjoy the outside. Fraser Health operated site.



Community Health Centre

The CHC is a 27,000-sq.-ft. facility with programs including primary care, a diabetes and seniors' clinic, public health, home health, mental health and substance use.

Emergency

Mission Memorial Hospital is a physician run community hospital. It provides primary acute care services including 24/7 emergency, outpatient and inpatient services, general medicine, laboratory and diagnostic services.
