TEN STEPS OF UNIVERSAL PRECAUTIONS IN PAIN MANAGEMENT.

- 1. Diagnosis with appropriate differential
- 2. Assessment of potential addiction risk
- 3. Informed consent
- 4. Treatment agreement written and signed
- 5. Pre/post intervention assessment of pain level and function
- 6. Appropriate trial of opioid therapy plus/minus adjunctive therapy
- 7. Reassessment of pain score and level of function
- 8. Regular reassessment of the 4 "A"s of pain medicine
 Analgesia
 Activity
 Adverse effects

Aberrant behaviours

- 9. Periodically review pain diagnosis and comorbid conditions including addictive disorders
- 10. DOCUMENT, DOCUMENT, DOCUMENT

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
