



How to enable pop-ups in Chrome, Firefox, Safari and Internet Explorer

Google Chrome

1. Click the **Chrome menu** on the browser toolbar.
2. Select **Settings**.
3. Click **Show advanced settings**.
4. In the "**Privacy**" section, click the **Content settings** button.
5. In the "**Pop-ups**" section, either select "**Allow all sites to show pop-ups**", or continue to step 6.
6. Customize permissions for specific websites by clicking **Manage exceptions**
7. Enter **website URL** and click **Allow**, then **OK**.
8. Close Google Chrome, reopen it.

Firefox

1. Click on the **Open Menu button**, then select **Options** (for Mac, start from the **Firefox** menu under the Finder and select **Preferences**). You can also use the Tools menu if you press **F10** or the **ALT** key.
2. Click the **Content** tab.
3. The checkbox listed is **Block pop-up windows**;
from here either allow all pop-ups by un-checking this box or continue to step 4.
4. Click the **Exceptions** box.
5. Enter **website URL** and click **Allow**, then **OK** (if applicable).
6. Close Firefox, reopen it.

Safari

1. Go to the Safari menu and choose '**Preferences**' from the list of choices
2. Click on the **Security** heading.
3. Un-check the box marked '**Block pop-up windows**' if you would like Safari to allow all popups – selectively blocking pop-ups is not an option with Safari
4. Close safari, reopen it.

Internet Explorer

1. Click **Internet Options** on the **Tools** menu to open the Internet Properties dialog box.
2. Click the **Privacy** tab;
from here either allow all pop-ups by un-checking **Turn on Pop-up Blocker** or continue to step 3.
3. Click to clear **Settings** to the right of the "**Turn on Pop-up Blocker**" option
4. Enter **website URL** and click **Add**
5. Close Explorer, reopen it.
