### Week of Jan. 21st Updates

We have now completed our consultation events across the North Shore and a final report will be available soon. Thank you to all the physicians who took the time out of their busy days to attend.

In September 2018, an Expression of Interest was submitted collaboratively between VCH/North Shore Division. In November 2018, our proposal was accepted by the MOH. February 1, 2019 will be the official kick off for developing a Primary Care Network Service Plan to present to MOH on June 3, 2019.

Ongoing: Physicians/GP Focus Group has been formed to provide input to the process and will be meeting on an ad-hoc basis to discuss challenges around creating our Service Plan. We have currently five committed physicians from a range of areas who are contributing to this group. We may need more physicians to join this group. Staff and physician representatives from the North Shore Division, as part of wave 2 communities, participated in a 2-day kick-off event last week. the purpose of this event was to share lessons learned from wave 1a and 1b communities and provide further clarity on service planning.
